3 INT./EXT KOMBI/REAL ESTATE OFFICE - DAY

INSIDE VAN: An ecstatically happy, wildly attractive, 30s caucasian City Slicker MALE AND FEMALE COUPLE adorned in gold and diamond jewellery.

The Female is driving. She turns on the radio and they both sing along:

Play song: "Rock Eternity"

BOTH Well I've been lay back feelin' fine workin' playin' by my design lookin' for love if it comes my way taken what life dictates I may taken what life dictates I may yeah Lady luck smiles you stand a chance until then why don't you dance... come on and dance...

FADE SONG:

They slow down as they approach the only building to be seen. An idyllic old-style Real Estate Office. She pulls over and turns the radio off.

4 EXT. REAL ESTATE OFFICE - DAY

CUT TO:

5 EXT. REAL ESTATE OFFICE - DAY

They scurry back into the Kombi and drive off.

The unseen Salesperson's hand flips the "FOR SALE" Sign to "SOLD"

CUT TO:

6 EXT. RIVER JETTY - AFTERNOON

The happy Couple are laughing and enjoying their new-found lifestyle.

They are celebrating with a picnic banquet of treats and champagne, kissing and cuddling.

They test the water, dangling their feet into the murky water.

They splash and kick loudly spraying water over each other.

CUT TO:

7 EXT. DOWN RIVER - AFTERNOON

A CROCODILE laying on the muddy bank scurries into the water.

CUT TO:

8 EXT. RIVER JETTY - AFTERNOON

The Couple stand and take their clothes off. Holding hands they jump in.

CUT TO:

9 EXT. UNDERWATER - CONTINUOUS

Shafts of green tinged sunlight pierce the now clearer water. SLOW MOTION

The Couple dive deeper beside the jetty's piles exploring.

They swim back under the jetty towards the bank and through lush green reeds gently swaying in the current.

REAL TIME

A FLASH IMAGE of a long dark creature swims across the screen behind them.

Unaware and innocent as children, they continue.

Suddenly, they come upon a one-metre-diameter circle of shiny razor-sharp barbed wire floating vertically resembling the "Jesus Crown of Thorns".

The Couple appear shocked for a moment, then once again indulge themselves in the wonder of their adventure and...

One-by-one swim through the mysterious gauntlet.

CUT TO:

10 EXT. RIVER JETTY - CONTINUOUS

SILENCE

Hold for 10 seconds on the empty jetty.

Then a gentle breeze slowly grows in intensity to a HOWLING WIND.

CUT TO:

11 EXT. UNDER RIVER JETTY - RIVER BANK - LATER

Calm returns as the Woman pops her head up beside the bank and slowly wipes her face, exhilarated!

The Man is nowhere to be seen.

Further down the bank, she notices a fat old CROCODILE slowly rise and meander towards her, like a tame puppy.

The Woman smiles, completely at peace with nature.

CLOSE UP:

The CROCODILE turns and comes nose to nose with the Woman.

Hold scene for 3 seconds:

She is completely bemused by the experience.

WOMAN Oh my, aren't you...

In a flash the CROCODILE tilts its head and snaps at her face:

CRUNCH!

The Crocodile pulls back immediately nose to nose and remains motionless.

The Woman's face is crushed and bloody, she slurs her final word:

WOMAN (CONT'D) (slur) Beautiful...

CUT TO:

13 EXT/INT. TRAFFIC JAM/LIMO/CARSALES YARD - MORNING

Inside is a well-to-do AUSTRALIAN INDIGENOUS COUPLE fighting and stressed out. Their argument can barely be heard.

The DRIVER disengages from the argument and looks out the window at the Car Sales Yard.

The GOTH/FETISH SALESWOMAN is placing the "FOR SALE" Sign back inside the same old Kombi.

The PASSENGER in the Limo notices the other lost in thought, they both look out at the Kombi.

They smile and kiss, then rush out of the Limo!
