INT. CHRIS AND JAMES' APT., WESTWOOD-NIGHT

Chris and his roommate James are having their nightly black jack game with friends at their apartment. The TV in the back is turned towards them so they can see any sports updates.

JAMES

You guys are terrible at Black Jack you know that?

ANT

You have a hot hand that's all.

JAMES

Hot hand? This is the third night in a row. I mean look at my chips.

CHRIS

We're playing with Oreos James, Oreos. Besides you're cheating.

JAMES

It's not cheating in Black Jack unless you're counting cards.

ANT

Yeah and we all know you suck at math J-BIRD.

JAMES

I got a C in math and don't call me J-bird, you know I hate it when you call me that.

James starts channel surfing until it stops on CNN where there is a breaking news alert.

ANT

Guys hold on for a second, this looks kind of important.

JAMES

Since when did you start watching the news?

ANT

The same night I was watching your mom, now be quiet.

The volume turns up on the TV as the reporter begins to speak.

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TV REPORTER

For those of you who are just tuning in, we have just received word that the Federal Reserve is completely unaware where \$9.1 trillion dollars has gone. Sources say that the General Council of the money-making power house apparently cannot account for trillions of dollars in off-balance sheet transactions. We now go live to Republican Richard Moore on this matter.

RICHARD MOORE

Look it's quite simple, the Federal Reserve is responsible for the economic crisis and central banking system. The system is in complete disarray. Our dollar is not backed by gold anymore. The Federal Reserve was built for the elite, and inflation will wipe out the middle class for our future generation. Something needs to change and change now!

TV REPORTER #2

CHRIS

JAMES

CHRIS

My mother just got a letter in the mail saying she will be laid off at the end of the month.

(CONTINUED)

ANT

It's like back-to-back bad news.

Chris sits in his chair staring at an American flag hanging in the kitchen not even paying attention to his friends or what's going on. The noise around him becomes muffled and he realizes something is wrong, and something has to be done.

CHRIS

I'll be right back.

Chris hurries out of the door.

JAMES

Wait, are you going to split or are you going to hit?

CHRIS

Hit.

The door shuts behind Chris. Ant hits Chris' hand, an Ace is flipped over, which makes his hand "21".

ANT

Damn it...Wait, does anybody have anymore Oreos?

INT. PROFESSOR LONDON'S OFFICE-NIGHT

Chris rushes through the hallways to catch his teacher at his office before he leaves.

CHRIS

Professor!

He knocks repeatedly until Mr. London notices him there.

PROFESSOR LONDON

Calm down, calm down what's the matter?

CHRIS

Look even though I was sleeping, I heard a few things that you were saying.

PROFESSOR LONDON

You recorded my lecture with a digital recorder didn't you?

(CONTINUED)

CHRIS

..Let's not point fingers here, but you said something about a revolution and having a voice,..and the rest is a little blurry because the battery died, so I missed the part about starting a revolution and--

Professor London laughs hysterically before drinking his coffee, because clearly he doesn't think Chris is serious.

PROFESSOR LONDON

Chris I think you need to worry about passing my class before you "Start a Revolution".

CHRIS

No, I'm serious. Come on Professor you saw the news. Something is going on.

PROFESSOR LONDON

Then write the Government a letter. Good night Chris.

CHRIS

No, wait! OK, let me ask you this. Hypothetically speaking, of course, if I were to start a revolution and bring attention to the government, what do I need to do?

PROFESSOR LONDON

EXT. OUTSIDE COURTYARD AREA DAY

books, blueprints and newspapers, waiting for James to show
up.

JAMES
You know a simple text or a phone
call would have been better.

CHRIS
Not for what I'm about to show you.

JAMES
What's up?

CHRIS
Do you know anything about the
Federal Reserve?

JAMES
Yeah, it's a big building where
they do very important things..Of
course I know what the Federal
Reserve is. Why?

CHRIS
Take a look at this.

Chris opens a book a shows it to James.

CHRIS (CONTD)
In the last 60 years the Federal
Reserve has been a private
organization, printing and lending
money to banks and other secret
fundings. Since 2000, it's been
over printing money and putting
corporations in debt.

JAMES
Skip the history lesson and tell me
what's going on.

Before Chris begins to speak, he steps back and takes a deep
breath before continuing his point.

(CONTINUED)

CHRIS

..I want to rob the Federal Reserve.

James looks at Chris for a second then breaks out with a loud laugh.

JAMES

Are you serious? You can't be serious. Wait you're serious aren't you?

CHRIS

I'm dead serious. I know I can't use a computer, but I still have connections to a few hackers that can pull the job. I just need a few--

JAMES

--This is not some movie! You can't just waltz right into the Federal Reserve and rob them. It's like--it's like trying to sneak into Fort Knox! It can't happen, it will not happen!

CHRIS

Really?

JAMES

Yes really. Even if you Google the phrase "rob" and "Federal Reserve" the feds will be making a very personal house call. And it's not gonna be that nice cleaning lady who comes to the apartment once a month.

CHRIS

I know it sounds crazy but I have a plan.

JAMES

A plan! You out of all people have a plan?

CHRIS

JAMES

(CONTINUED)

CHRIS

CHRIS

JAMES
Help you!? What am I getting out of this other than life in prison, and possibly rooming with some guy name Frank? And besides, you have something on your ankle called a monitoring devise, and last time I checked, New York is 3,000 miles that way!

CHRIS

JAMES

CHRIS

INT. OLD FACTORY-NIGHT.

Chris and James are waiting in the factory for any help that may walk through the door.

JAMES

I don't want to sound negative, but when you tell people that you want to rob the Federal Reserve, you're not going to get a lot of followers.

CHRIS

Is that how you pitched it to people?

JAMES

Yeah why?

CHRIS

You're an idiot you know that?

JAMES

You're the one that wants to steal from the Federal Reserve and start a "revolution", and you're calling me an idiot?

As they continue to argue, they hear the door slowly open, and hear a loud voice echo from afar.

ORTHODOX

Chris, you sneaky son of a bitch!

Chris is shocked and smiles from ear to ear as he gives his old friend the "secret handshake".

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CHRIS

Dox! What the hell are you doing here man. It's good to see you.

ORTHODOX

It's good to see you to bro.

CHRIS

How'd you hear about this?

ORTHODOX

Well, James isn't so bright. He put "we're meeting at the factory today to start a revolution" on Twitter. But on the other hand, it did sound like something that you were putting together.

CHRIS

You used Twitter?

JAMES

You said to get as many people as I could.

CHRIS

Anyways, the three of us alone can't pull this job off. We're still going to need more people.

ORTHODOX

Come on Chris, you didn't think I'd come without bearing gifts did you?

The door again opens and in comes some of his old friends that he used to work with, including some new faces.

CHRIS

Dox, you are a freak of nature! Thank you.

ORTHODOX

I wouldn't miss this for the world kid.

CHRIS

Is Dom coming?

ORTHODOX

Come on man, you know he ain't coming. He still blames you for what happened.

(CONTINUED)

CHRIS

It was everyone's fault, and you know that.

ORTHODOX

Well he doesn't see it that way.

CHRIS

Is that "Herm the Worm" over there?

ORTHODOX

Yeah why?

CHRIS

He's one of the best hackers in the world. How did you manage to get him?

ORTHODOX

He dates my sister.

CHRIS

Interesting.

The group of ten are gathered around a table with blueprints and stacks of papers. As they quiet down, Chris looks around and begins to speak.

CHRIS

OK. The Federal Reserve has announced that they cannot account for \$9.1 trillion dollars. I think it's bull shit. The so called "government" has turned the other cheek in hoping that we will get over it and move on.

MIKE

What about the President?

CHRIS

The President is just a puppet, he has nothing to do with it.

RANDY

So what are you suggesting?

CHRIS

Look at the blueprint in front of you. It's an old copy of the Federal Reserve and all of it's rooms and their underground tunnels. If you look closely,

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(CONTINUED)

CHRIS (cont'd)
there's an underground tunnel that
leads to a train station.

HERM
You're talking about the secret
railroad that President Roosevelt
took in order to avoid any threat?

CHRIS
That's right.

HERM
But that's a myth. It never really
existed.

CHRIS
No, it did. And guess who funded
it?

Before Chris can even finish, he is interrupted by Briana
who walks up to the table and into the light.

BRIANA
It's an organization called the
"Elite".

JAMES
You mean the characters from the DC
comic stories?

ORTHODOX
No Einstein, she's talking about
the secret society.

CHRIS
How did you know that?

BRIANA
Because--

HERM
--Because her father is Republican
Kevin Perry, a 3rd degree "Elitist"
which makes her a threat to this
plan. In other words were fucked.

JAMES
Can someone please tell me what the
hell is going on?

BRIANA

Look, I don't like my father just as much as you guys, but don't be so quick to make assumptions on who I am and what I'm about. I came here to help, but clearly my help is not needed.

BRIANA
