INT. DIRTY BEDROOM - FLASHBACK

A dirty, dark room. A passed out prostitute is on the bed, drugs on the side table next to her. Heroin.

Ethan and Sebastian stand over the top of her. Sebastian smiles and kneels down next to her.

Sebastian moves her hair out from in front of her face, touching her, lovingly.

Ethan puts his hands in his pockets, swallows hard, nervous.

ETHAN You don't have to listen to me.

SEBASTIAN

I know.

ETHAN You need to calm all of this down.

SEBASTIAN

I can't.

ETHAN You're doing too much, spreading yourself too thin.

SEBASTIAN No, I'm only going to keep growing.

ETHAN

Think.

SEBASTIAN I want a whole army of girls like her.

ETHAN An army, look at her?

Sebastian isn't listening.

SEBASTIAN And I'll never even know her name, it's perfect.

ETHAN But she knows yours.

Sebastian stands back up, turns to face Ethan.

LAURA Why do you keep asking me that?

SEBASTIAN

Recognise.

LAURA

LAURA

SEBASTIAN I can kill you whenever I want to.

I know.

What?

SEBASTIAN

Help me.

LAURA You're insane.

SEBASTIAN There's nothing else you can do.

LAURA Just let me go.

SEBASTIAN Look where you are. Go on.

Laura keeps her eyes locked on him, unblinking.

Tears stream down Laura's face.

Laura tries to talk, but again the gag makes her words hard to hear.

LAURA I just want to go back home.

SEBASTIAN Your home is mine now. You've got nothing to go back to.

Laura is still crying, starts coughing.

LAURA

Take this off. Please.

SEBASTIAN

The more upset you make yourself, the harder you're making it for yourself.

LAURA I can't help you like this.

SEBASTIAN You're not even trying.

LAURA Take it off. SEBASTIAN You think it's hard to breathe now, how do you think you're going to be after I slit your throat? LAURA I can't help you then, you've messed up. SEBASTIAN You're different from other girls I say that much. LAURA Messed up bad. SEBASTIAN How's that? LAURA I've never taken anything from you. SEBASTIAN I didn't say that you had. LAURA I've done nothing wrong to you. SEBASTIAN OK. LAURA SEBASTIAN You're wrong. LAURA

I don't know where your money is, I've got nothing to give you.

Nothing. I'm the worst person you could have picked up.

SEBASTIAN You better hope you're wrong about that.

CUT TO:

23.

INT. VAN - DAY

Lent back against the wall Laura is concentrating on getting her breathing settled.

Laura stands up, with hesitant footsteps she approaches the vans back doors.

With a bang the back doors open up and light comes pouring in.

The second masked man climbs in with a packet of sandwiches and a bottle of water in his hands.

He heads over towards Laura, places the water and the sandwiches down in front of her.

He turns to head back out, Laura grunts at him.

LAURA

I want to see your face.

The second masked man points down at the sandwiches and water by her feet.

He mimes that she needs to eat and drink it.

Laura stamps down on the sandwiches, crushing, smashing and destroying them.

With her bound together hands Laura grabs hold of the water bottle unscrews its lid and pours it all out onto the floor in front of him.

Throws the empty bottle at his face. The second masked man dodges out of the way, just missing.

LAURA There's no way.

SEBASTIAN It's either a bathroom break now or I get you a bucket to use.

LAURA I'm not an animal.

SEBASTIAN So, what do you think about it now?

LAURA You can't treat me like this.

SEBASTIAN I own you now, I can do whatever I like.

LAURA Then why ask me anything?

Sebastian eyes Laura up coldly.

SEBASTIAN You're an asset, a bargaining chip.

LAURA And what does that make you?

SEBASTIAN Focus and tell me which one is it?

LAURA What is it that you want me to say, you're clearly not interested in the truth.

SEBASTIAN Help me and you're free.

LAURA I can't help you.

SEBASTIAN Look at you. You can't last here.

LAURA Don't you think I already know that.

SEBASTIAN You don't have it in you. It's pathetic.

30.

LAURA Ethan didn't tell me to go anywhere, I was leaving him.

SEBASTIAN

Bullshit.

LAURA

Once I found a place to stay I was going to call Ethan and tell him that it's over between us.

SEBASTIAN That's a lie.

LAURA

But I'm here instead.

SEBASTIAN

Call him.

LAURA And tell him what?

SEBASTIAN Pick a motel, tell him you're there. Tell him to meet you.

LAURA That's your idea?

SEBASTIAN

Do it.

LAURA He won't do it.

Sebastian stands up, he walks around behind Laura.

Sebastian delivers a hard kick to the back of Laura's head.

Laura's face slams down against the floor knocking a tooth out, blood sprays out and pools underneath her, she's out cold.

Sebastian pockets her phone and exits the van.

CUT TO:

INT. VAN - DAY

The Second man in the ski mask climbs into the back of the van.

31.

He takes off the mask. NOAH, 29, handsome with short cut hair.

Laura shuts her eyes.

NOAH It's OK you can look at me.

LAURA

No.

NOAH Do you want something for your tooth?

Laura slowly opens her eyes.

LAURA To have it back in my mouth, can you do that?

NOAH

No.

LAURA I've aged ten years since been here.

NOAH I'm sorry you're going through this.

LAURA I want to go home, but I don't even have one anymore.

NOAH

No?

LAURA I've got nothing.

Noah reaches into his pocket and takes out her mobile phone.

NOAH If you help us you can go.

LAURA He's not listened to a single thing I've said.

NOAH Why are you protecting him? Tell him that you need him.

32.

LAURA I was going to end it, end the marriage. Do you know that?

NOAH This can end if you want it to.

LAURA Don't you dare hit me as well.

NOAH I wouldn't.

LAURA You're just like him.

NOAH

I'm not.

Noah moves behind Laura and Laura filches.

Noah undoes Laura's hands and frees her wrists.

Noah forces Laura's phone into her hand.

NOAH (CONT'D) Call him and tell him where you are.

LAURA Seriously?

NOAH Tell him what's been happening, he needs to know.

LAURA You can't find him can you?

NOAH

Please.

LAURA That's why I'm still here.

NOAH

Do it.

LAURA If you find him you'll kill me won't you?

NOAH Tell him where you are, let him know.

33.

LAURA I picked the worst time to runaway didn't I? NOAH He must be worried about you. LAURA You don't know him too well do you? Laura first uses the phone to see her reflection. She inspects her mouth. NOAH Teeth can be fixed, replaced. LAURA I can't believe this is happening to me. NOAH You're still alive aren't you? LAURA Why can't you just let me go? NOAH Help us and you can walk out of here all on your own. LAURA Us? NOAH Call him. LAURA You're a psychopath too? NOAH No. Laura finds Ethan's number and calls him it goes straight to voice mail. LAURA You see. NOAH OK. LAURA I knew it.

34.

NOAH Go on, say something. As the voice mail is activated, Laura hangs up. LAURA No? NOAH You need to find out where he is. LAURA Do it yourself. NOAH I'm trying to help you. LAURA Is that a joke? NOAH No. LAURA Are you trying to be funny right now? NOAH Your time is running out. CUT TO: INT. VAN - DAY Noah has a wet cloth in his hand. Noah wipes the dry blood clean from around Laura's mouth. Cleaning her up. LAURA What makes you think he'll even tell me where he is? Noah points to the wedding ring on Laura's finger. NOAH You wanted to spend the rest of your life with him. LAURA I wanted a family. NOAH Yeah?

35.

LAURA I wanted to find someone to spend the rest of my life with.

NOAH Sounds nice.

LAURA It's what everyone else has.

NOAH Most people are miserable.

LAURA After meeting you I'm not surprised.

NOAH You wanted to leave him.

LAURA

Yes.

Noah pulls out a tablet device, a GPS map showing their current location.

NOAH Just help us.

LAURA What do you want me to do with that?

NOAH Put in an address.

LAURA You literally haven't got a clue have you?

NOAH Lets find him together.

LAURA

No.

NOAH Where do you think?

LAURA

A guess?

NOAH Yes, take a guess.
36.

LAURA You kidnaped me to make guesses? NOAH You're still married to him. LAURA And? NOAH Doesn't that mean you know him better than anyone else? LAURA From day one, he never once let his guard down around me. NOAH So you're not going to help? LAURA With him I was trapped, I'm trapped here. I can't help anyone.

Noah picks up the binds that were wrapped around Laura's ankles and wrists.

NOAH I don't want to have to put these back on you.

LAURA Then don't.

Noah drops the binds to the floor.

NOAH Just stay where you are.

LAURA

Fine.

NOAH I can't ask any nicer than that.

LAURA I never love him by the way.

NOAH

OK.

37.

LAURA I just wanted you to know that. I was just so desperate to be like everyone else, I should never had said 'I Do.'

CUT TO:

EXT. CITY STREET - DAY

Sebastian drags Laura out of the back of a van and towards another waiting one, it's almost identical.

Laura shuffles forwards before stumbling to the floor.

Sebastian tries to hold Laura up but she's too heavy.

LAURA Tell me where you're taking me.

SEBASTIAN

Get up.

LAURA

Tell me.

SEBASTIAN This isn't a game.

Laura tries to get up but falls back down again.

LAURA I won't move until I know.

SEBASTIAN

Get up.

LAURA

Just tell me.

Sebastian points at the second van.

SEBASTIAN It's right there.

Sebastian tries to drag her up but Laura resists. Noah steps forwards, he undoes the binds around her ankles.

As Noah undoes them Laura has her legs free.

Sebastian again reaches down to lift her up, this time she lets him.

38.

Sebastian takes her over towards the second van. Laura lashes out, slamming both fists into his stomach.

Laura knocks the wind out of Sebastian.

Sebastian doubles over, gasping for breath.

Laura makes a run for it.

Sebastian looks across at Noah.

SEBASTIAN (CONT'D) Get her, kill her if you have to.

INT. APARTMENT - BATHROOM - FLASHBACK

The sound of a trains horn bleeds in through the window.

Laura's in bed with Ethan, her eyes snaps open. Laura reaches over and wakes him up.

LAURA

I want to go home.

Ethan slowly wakes up, another train horn fills the bedroom.

Ethan reaches over to the bedside table, gets himself a cigarette and lights it up, smoking.

ETHAN If you're struggling have a glass of wine.

LAURA

No.

ETHAN

Go on.

LAURA I don't want wine. I just want to sleep.

ETHAN So waking me up is going to help you do that how?

LAURA If I had my own bed I'd be fine.

ETHAN Quit complaining.

39.

LAURA We're spending more and more time out here and I don't like it.

Another train horn.

ETHAN I prefer this one.

LAURA And that, I've had enough of it. (Points at the cigarette) And that.

ETHAN

What?

LAURA The noise was bad enough but now it's going to stink in here.

ETHAN

Are you finished?

LAURA

I want to go. I'm supposed to sleep in here and you're smoking. How many times do I have to ask you to stop before you'll actually do it?

ETHAN You know, you're really starting to get on my nerves.

Laura goes to take the cigarette out of Ethan's mouth but he knocks her hand away.

Ethan stubs it out, lays back down.

ETHAN (CONT'D) We're not going anywhere.

LAURA This shouldn't be so hard.

ETHAN I've got too much to get through in the morning, I don't need this fucking shit right now.

Laura gets out of bed.

40.

LAURA I could get on one of those trains and leave?

Ethan closes his eyes.

ETHAN Come back to bed.

Laura turns her back on him, storms out of the room.

LAURA I can't breathe in here.

ETHAN Then you shouldn't have woken me up.

LAURA You should never have dragged me here.

ETHAN You're leaving?

LAURA Do you even care?

EXT. CITY STREET - DAY

Laura is out of breath, drenched in sweat. Her arms and legs pumping as hard as they can, sprinting, struggling but Laura refuses to stop.

Noah is right on Laura's heels, chasing after her.

Noah finds the pace much easier to keep.

Laura turns off the road, a sharp turn and comes down into an alley.

EXT. ALLEY - DAY

Noah catches up to her, wrapping his arms around Laura. Noah pulls Laura to a sudden stop.

Laura screams out for help.

Noah puts his hands around her mouth, muffling Laura's cries.

Noah drags Laura back the way they came.

41.

Laura stamps down on his foot.

Laura tries to throw her head back, a reverse head butt trying to connect her head against Noah's.

Noah holds onto Laura tighter.

NOAH

Stop it!

LAURA

NOAH

Let me go!

Laura kicks out at Noah, throwing her legs out wildly. With his arms still wrapped around her, Noah squeezes as tight as he can, squeezes the air out of her, squeezing the fight out of her.

You can't get away from me. LAURA Let me go! NOAH It's over Laura, I've got you. LAURA Don't do this! NOAH You can't get out of this by running. Noah releases his grip a little. LAURA I hate you! NOAH I'm not the one who did this to you. Laura has tears rolling down her face. LAURA I hate you the most! NOAH Why? LAURA You could have let me go!

42.

NOAH And why would I do that?

Laura lowers her head, doesn't have an answer.

INT. SECOND VAN - DAY

Sebastian has a knee to the back of Laura's neck. Noah watches on from outside as Sebastian keeps Laura pinned down to the floor.

Sebastian has his whole weight pressed down, he again ties up her ankles, pulling the binds as tight as he can.

It's the same with Laura's wrists. Sebastian pulls them so tight that the ropes begin cutting into her skin.

Sebastian rolls Laura over. Still sitting on Laura, Sebastian pulls out a gun and holds it in front of Laura's face.

SEBASTIAN Why would you have pulled a stunt like that?

Laura stares right back at him. Laura doesn't even blink.

Sebastian rolls Laura back onto her stomach. He puts the gag back in her mouth and pulls as hard as he can. Overly tight.

Laura's choking, she can't breath.

Sebastian keeps pulling, finally tying it at the back of her head.

Sebastian climbs off of Laura, leaving Laura gasping for air her whole body shaking.

Sebastian jumps down out of the van.

Noah waits for Sebastian to leave out of sight.

Laura is choking, still fighting and failing to get in air.

With her hands bound so tightly there's nothing she can do.

Scratching at her face Laura tries to get the gag out of her mouth, can't do it.

Laura's not breathing at all.

Noah moves over to her. Noah grabs onto the gag and loosens it, taking it off.

43.

Noah rolls Laura onto her side and finally she can breathe again. He keeps her on her side.

NOAH

It's OK.

Coughing and spitting Laura regains her breathing. Laura looks up at Noah.

LAURA Why do you care, you're the one who brought me back here.

NOAH You would already be dead if I didn't.

LAURA

Yeah?

NOAH I don't want to see you die.

LAURA

No?

NOAH I want to see you survive this.

INT. SECOND VAN - FRONT SEATS - DAY

In the front of the van Sebastian sits at the wheel with Noah in the front passenger seat beside him.

Sebastian searches through a couple of radio stations before he turns it off, disinterred.

SEBASTIAN She talks to you more than she does with me.

NOAH She's a trophy wife.

SEBASTIAN Don't believe a fucking thing that comes out of her mouth.

NOAH She's not saying anything though.

SEBASTIAN Keep talking to her.

44.

NOAH

OK.

SEBASTIAN No matter what I have to do, I'm getting my fucking money back.

NOAH She told me that she hated me.

SEBASTIAN Well make her like you then, get me something.

NOAH

I'll try.

SEBASTIAN

She knows more than she's saying.

NOAH

If you say so.

SEBASTIAN

I've always known when people are lying to me and she's full of shit.

NOAH I'm just not so sure.

SEBASTIAN

I won't be able to bargain with damaged goods but if she doesn't start giving me something soon I'll start pulling her fucking teeth right out of her head.

NOAH

Maybe you should try a nicer way with her?

SEBASTIAN

Why, without a doubt I'm killing this bitch at the end of all of this anyway.

EXT. CITY STREET - DAY

Sebastian and Noah drag Laura out of the back of the van, only to load her into the back of another.

Sebastian shoves Laura inside, moves around to the driver seat, while Noah gets into the back with her.

45.

Laura and Noah bounce around in the back as the van comes to a stop. LAURA Don't touch me, stay away from me.

INT. THIRD VAN - DAY

NOAH Fine, but I don't know where we're going either.

LAURA

No?

NOAH So don't ask.

LAURA What kind of kidnapping is this?

NOAH Just sit still.

LAURA Aren't you going to take me to some kind of safe house.

NOAH Is that what you want?

LAURA I'm tried and hungry. And I don't care how it sounds but I want a shower.

The back door is ripped open, Sebastian signals for Laura to get out.

NOAH

Come on.

LAURA

No.

Sebastian pulls out his gun and takes aim.

SEBASTIAN You come out now or I'll shoot your kneecaps out and drag you.

Ransom Payback - Simonkyleparker@hotmail.co.uk 46. EXT. LOTTIE'S HOUSE - DAY Laura, with her hands shaking rings the door bell to a modest looking townhouse. Laura has Noah with her, Sebastian watches on from the van, parked out front. Lottie answers the door in her dressing gown, looks down at Laura, sad. LOTTIE Oh Laura, I'm so sorry. LAURA Hi. LOTTIE I've been so worried for you. LAURA So people know what's happened to me? LOTTIE Yes. LAURA Everyone's talking about me? LOTTIE Yeah. LAURA Do you know where he is? LOTTIE No. LAURA Does anybody? LOTTIE You shouldn't have brought them here. LAURA I'm sorry we fought with each other. LOTTIE I'm sorry about what's happened to you but I don't want to get involved.

Laura shows her that she's missing a tooth, inside her badly bruised mouth.

LAURA Look at what they've done to me.

Lottie turns her attention onto Noah, gestures to Laura.

LOTTIE I don't know where is he.

LAURA He can't have just disappeared into thin air.

Lottie keeps her eyes locked on Noah, ignoring Laura.

LOTTIE I don't even know her that well.

LAURA

What?

LOTTIE I can't help her.

LAURA So we were never friends were we?

LOTTIE She's wasting your time bringing you here.

LAURA

Lottie!

Still Lottie ignores Laura.

LOTTIE I had to be nice to her, my husband worked for hers. And that's it.

Lottie goes to close the door but Laura thrust out a hand stopping her.

LAURA You're a god damn liar.

LOTTIE Go away Laura.

LAURA How can you say this.

48.

LOTTIE

Please.

LAURA What's wrong with you, help me!

LOTTIE (to Laura) I can't help you and I wouldn't even want to if I could.

LAURA Have you always hated me?

LOTTIE Don't drag me into this Laura.

LAURA I've got no one else.

LOTTIE This is your problem, not mine.

LAURA After everything I've done for you.

LOTTIE

You and Ethan have both had this coming to you. Taking everyone's money so you could live better than everyone else. Well time's up. Give them what they want.

Lottie slams the door in her face.

Laura walks away.

A moment passes. Sebastian attacks and kicks the door in.

INT. LOTTIE'S HOUSE - KITCHEN - DAY

Sebastian has a fist full of Lottie's hair as he drags her along the floor behind him. Lottie's screaming, kicking out her legs.

Sebastian throws Lottie down to the floor with a bang.

SEBASTIAN Where's Ethan?!

Sebastian kicks Lottie in the ribs, knocks the air out of her.

49.

Lottie fights to get the air back into her lungs.

Lottie rolls over onto her back and looks up at Sebastian. She's a wreck, tears streaming down her face.

LOTTIE Please, how could I know?

SEBASTIAN Why won't you just help her? You tell me and she's free.

LOTTIE I don't even like that bitch.

SEBASTIAN You'll say anything, everyone lies to me.

LOTTIE Do whatever you want to her.

SEBASTIAN

Yeah?

LOTTIE I don't care. Kill her.

SEBASTIAN

Big words.

LOTTIE I don't know where he is.

SEBASTIAN Then why did she come here?

LOTTIE I don't know. I never liked her.

SEBASTIAN

Liar.

LOTTIE No one does. If it wasn't for Ethan no one would ever even talk to her.

Sebastian pulls out his gun and takes aim.

Lottie holds her hands in front of her face, trying to protect herself.

Sebastian unloads, shooting her in the chest and face. He spits down at her.

50.

SEBASTIAN No more lies.

INT. ETHAN'S HOUSE - KITCHEN - FLASHBACK

Ethan bare cheated and dressed only in a pain of long shorts sits up at the table, eating a basic looking microwaveable meal with a plastic fork.

JAMES, (30) and ALEX, (27) dressed in expensive clothes and each with a gold necklace on enter.

James heads for the fridge and removes a bottle of milk, gulps right from the bottle.

Alex sits down at the table with Ethan. Alex gives Ethan a roll of money, tied together with an elastic band.

ALEX You want to make this kind of money?

ETHAN

Of course.

ALEX We can get you work if you want it.

Ethan nods, reaches out and takes the money roll.

INT. THIRD VAN - DAY

Laura is on the floor of another van. Smaller and dirtier than the others. Noah stands over her, it's a rocky bumpy ride.

Laura looks Noah up and down.

LAURA You dress like you're poor.

NOAH Is that supposed to hurt my feelings?

LAURA I'm just wondering why you're doing this?

NOAH

Yeah?

51.

LAURA Why are you working for him, when it doesn't look like he pays you that well. NOAH

Money is the only reason I do this and the only reason why I'm here right now.

LAURA Kidnaping helpless women?

NOAH This is a first for me.

LAURA

Yeah?

NOAH I normally just drive.

LAURA Serious?

NOAH

I've got two older brothers, they both work for him.

LAURA They got your involved?

NOAH

Yeah.

LAURA Why do you stay when you know what he is?

NOAH He pays me well, I just don't waste it on clothes or shiny jewelry.

LAURA How can you stomach it?

NOAH Listen, all I have to do is turn up and keep my mouth shut.

LAURA But he's evil.

52.

NOAH So is your husband. LAURA But I left him.

NOAH Still married him though.

LAURA Where are your brothers now?

NOAH They're both in prison.

LAURA Doesn't that scare you?

NOAH They're both going to be there for a very long time.

LAURA I bet you can't wait to join them?

CUT TO:

INT. THIRD VAN - DAY

Laura finishes off her food, ravished. Laura almost licks her plate clean, burps.

Noah with his arms crossed in front of his chest. Noah leans back against the wall, watching Laura on the other side of the van, he laughs.

LAURA Do you honestly have to watch me every second?

He nods.

NOAH Do you want some more, didn't think you'd like it that much.

Laura places the plate down in front of her.

LAURA I can't survive like this.

NOAH I'll get you more food.

53.

LAURA Don't expect me to be grateful.

NOAH That's fine, you don't have to be.

LAURA I won't be.

NOAH I know if I was in your shoes, I wouldn't be too happy either.

LAURA You must know, what you're doing here you're only going to end up like your brothers.

NOAH And why do you care?

LAURA Is that really what you want?

NOAH Those two, they might be my big brothers but they were never smart, prison is a good place for them.

LAURA That's messed up.

NOAH It could be a lot worse.

LAURA

How?

NOAH It's good that they're both alive.

LAURA It's so sad though.

NOAH It would be worse, I mean my parents are both gone.

LAURA

54.

LAURA (CONT'D) Yeah, mine too.

NOAH

I left school when I was thirteen and started living on my own when I was fourteen.

LAURA

I was still playing with dolls at that age.

NOAH My brothers tried to help me out, but like I said neither of them are very smart.

LAURA

Wow.

NOAH I find it easier to visit them in prison than I would do having to visit their graves.

LAURA But don't you see?

NOAH

See what?

LAURA

It's going to be the same for you, prison or dead, they are your only choices.

NOAH

So what do you want from me, this is the only life I've ever known.

LAURA It doesn't have to be.

NOAH Am I proud of it no, but it could be a whole lot worse.

LAURA

You think?

NOAH

I'm not living on the streets, I don't beg and I don't owe a single thing to nobody.

55.

LAURA But look at what you're doing.

NOAH

I know where my money comes from and I know what I do to earn it.

LAURA Haven't you ever hoped for more?

NOAH You don't even know me.

LAURA No, but I'm beginning too. You want people to think you're bad but you're not.

Noah walks over and takes the plate from Laura, they share a moment. A shared glance as they smile at each other.

INT. MASSAGE ROOM - DAY

Ethan lays face down on a masseuse table whilst two topless GIRLS massage his shoulders and legs

INT. THIRD VAN - DAY

Laura and Noah are on the floor, facing each other.

Noah reaches into his pocket and removes a candy bar. Noah takes off the wrapper, snaps it in half and shares it with Laura.

Both eating.

NOAH I'm sorry if I scared you, when you first saw me.

LAURA Well I'm not scared anymore.

NOAH I should have taken the ski mask off and said something to you.

LAURA

Maybe.

NOAH I'm not even sure why I didn't. Maybe I was scared too. Laura's taken aback. LAURA What? NOAH You're my first. LAURA I am? NOAH It's my responsibility to look after you. LAURA Is that what he told you? NOAH I've never had to look after anyone before. LAURA I like seeing this. A bit of the real you. It's nice. NOAH OK. LAURA I knew you weren't so bad. NOAH You're a lot different to how I thought you'd be too. LAURA Thanks. EXT. CITY STREET - DAY The back doors of the van open, Sebastian gestures for Laura to come out, Noah takes hold of both of her arms. LAURA

Not another change.

INT. SEBASTIAN'S CAR - DAY

Sebastian is on the backseat with Laura. Laura stares at the back of Noah's head, he's sitting up front with Albert.

56.

57.

The car pulls up and parks in front of a seemingly high end massage and muscle therapy clinic its frontage gives it the appearance of appearing professional.

Sebastian points it out to her.

SEBASTIAN You know what this is don't you?

LAURA You know I do.

SEBASTIAN But say it, I want to hear you.

Laura shakes her head, defeated.

Sebastian reaches over and grabs her by the throat, he squeezes then releases choking Laura just for a moment.

LAURA

That hurts!

SEBASTIAN

Say it.

LAURA It's prostitutes.

SEBASTIAN Less than four hours ago your husband, forgetting his vows came here.

LAURA

Just stop.

SEBASTIAN You know of this place, you know your husband.

LAURA

And?

SEBASTIAN But you didn't tell me that he would come here?

LAURA How the fuck would I be able to guess that?

SEBASTIAN You didn't even try.

58.

LAURA Would you have believed me even if I did.

SEBASTIAN But you didn't.

LAURA I thought he would have left the country by now.

SEBASTIAN

Really?

LAURA What is it that you want me to say?

SEBASTIAN

The truth.

LAURA I told you I didn't know where he was and I was telling the truth.

SEBASTIAN You need to start thinking a lot harder.

LAURA

I can't.

SEBASTIAN You can pretend you don't know him, but I think you do.

LAURA You think all kinds of things.

SEBASTIAN You will find him for me, I do believe that.

Laura's crying.

LAURA I was trying to leave him, but the next thing I know I'm here with you.

Noah glances over his shoulder.

59.

NOAH I know this is hard, but you need to think of what other places like this he visits, where he might be now, even if it's embarrassing.

LAURA I don't know.

Sebastian puts an arm around Laura.

SEBASTIAN We're getting closer, just keep asking yourself.

LAURA Asking myself what?

SEBASTIAN Where might he be now?

INT. LAURA'S HOUSE - DINING ROOM - FLASHBACK

Another party, but the same. Loud music, lots of people, drinking, smoking and taking drugs.

Laura, dressed in another tight black dress sits crossed legged, a glass of wine in hand.

Laura watches Ethan, who's sitting on the opposite end of the room, handing out small bags of drugs in exchange for money.

People crowd around him, the men shake his hand and the girls kiss him, some longer and more over the top than others.

They all hand over large amounts of cash.

Laura stands up and heads over to him.

LAURA Enough Ethan, everyone is watching you.

Ethan flashes some of the money at Laura.

ETHAN

I'm working.

LAURA Yeah and there's not a single person here who can't see it.

60.

ETHAN Why don't you go and get yourself another drink?

LAURA Take a break Ethan.

ETHAN

What's the matter, what do you want?

Laura tries to push Ethan's hands down but he doesn't let her.

LAURA

Ethan, stop.

ETHAN Go away Laura, you're putting me in a bad mood.

LAURA I don't want this.

ETHAN Go be boring some place else, please.

INT. THIRD VAN - DAY

Laura and Noah are again in the back of the van. Not moving, each with their back against a wall. On opposite ends facing each other.

> LAURA I can see it in your eyes.

NOAH What's that?

LAURA You want to ask me something, so just go ahead and ask it.

Noah laughs to himself.

NOAH Well yeah there is.

LAURA

Go on then.

NOAH

NOAH

Spaghetti that you have to boil, I didn't know that was real thing.

LAURA

Well when I first saw dried spaghetti for the first time I thought they were just really long brittle toothpicks.

NOAH

No you did not.

LAURA

I did.

NOAH That's being an idiot, not poor.

LAURA Ran out of things to say?

NOAH

No.

LAURA Looks like I'm winning.

NOAH Winning what?

LAURA The poor kid competition.

NOAH You think so?

LAURA

I've got another hundred stories that I could tell you.

NOAH

Ethan is dressed in a suit and tie. Laura wearing a towel with a second wrapped tightly around her soaking wet hair sits crossed-legged and arms folded on the edge of the bed.

LAURA Do you miss it Grandma?

Olive looks across at her, wide eyed and terrified.

OLIVE I want the television on.

Laura turns to face Olive.

LAURA

Maybe you wouldn't be so bad if you were back at the farm?

OLIVE I want to watch the news. Put the television on now.

LAURA They don't let you have a television on in here.

OLIVE

Now.

LAURA You don't have one.

OLIVE Then what use are you?

Laura moves over and sits down on the edge of the bed.

LAURA You're getting so much worse.

OLIVE

Laura.

LAURA It makes me sick seeing you like this.

68.

Laura reaches out a hand to touch Olive on the side of the face, Olive recoils back in fear.

OLIVE

Don't touch me.

LAURA

It's OK.

OLIVE Put the television on and get out of my house.

LAURA Do you even remember what the farm looks like anymore.

OLIVE

Go on.

LAURA It's nothing like this.

OLIVE Go on, go away!

LAURA

Grandma.

OLIVE Stop calling me that! I don't know who you are.

Laura lets the tears fall, rolling down her cheeks.

LAURA What a mess, is this going to happen to me one day too?

OLIVE

GET OUT!

The door to the room opens behind them, KATIE, 27, short, long brown hair and dressed in a nurses uniform comes in.

KATIE Is everything OK, it's not good for anyone to get your Grandma so upset.

LAURA It's this place that's upsetting her.

Katie walks past Laura and places her hands onto Olive's shoulders, guiding her back down onto the bed.

KATIE

It's OK, try and get some sleep.

Olive lays back and closes her eyes.

LAURA She's getting worse.

Katie comes over to Laura, takes her by the arm and gently guides her over to the door.

KATIE She's very ill your grandma, I know how hard this is.

LAURA

You do?

KATIE Believe me I've gone through something like this myself.

LAURA Then I want her made better.

KATIE You really need to be planning for the end.

LAURA

No.

KATIE She's sick.

LAURA I won't let her go. I want to

take her back to the farm.

KATIE

You don't get to have a say.

LAURA

Yes I do, whilst I have money. I can keep looking after her.

KATIE You can't take her back.

LAURA That farm needs someone living there.

INT. SEBASTIAN'S SECOND CAR - DAY

If he's dumb enough to go and see fucking prostitutes when he should be busy trying to get away I can't see him being so stupid as to come here as if nothing has happened.

NOAH Maybe he doesn't think anything has happened?

LAURA What, doesn't know that his own fucking wife has been kidnapped?

71.

NOAH Well you know him better than I do.

LAURA

And Sebastian knows him better than I do.

NOAH Kidnapping usually brings family members closer together, but I guess not this time.

LAURA He doesn't love me, he let me get taken.

NOAH

You think?

LAURA

He let this happen to me, he's not going to pay Sebastian anything, if he could, if he wanted to, he would have already.

NOAH I don't know about that.

LAURA

He wanted you to find me, he wanted you to take me.

NOAH Did he know you would leave him?

No.

Yes.

LAURA I have to get myself out of this.

NOAH Sebastian only wants his money back.

LAURA He's not going to get it.

NOAH When he finds Ethan he will.

LAURA I don't want to die Noah. I've got to go.

NOAH Let them find him then.

LAURA He's not going to.

NOAH

No?

LAURA Sebastian isn't smart enough to find him.

NOAH How can you be so sure?

73.

LAURA Ethan has been stealing from him for years.

NOAH

For years?

LAURA Ethan took what he wanted and now he's gone.

INT. LAURA'S HOUSE - ETHAN'S OFFICE - FLASHBACK

Sebastian, with both hands grabs Ethan at the neck and slams him against the wall behind him.

SEBASTIAN Do you have any idea how replaceable you are?!

ETHAN I wouldn't do anything to hurt you.

Sebastian tightens his grip, Ethan's face turns bright but he doesn't do anything to stop him.

SEBASTIAN You're smart, yeah? (Ethan nods) Then why do I keep hearing things?

Sebastian releases his hold and Ethan gasps.

ETHAN I don't know, I like what I do.

SEBASTIAN Just add up the numbers, what could be simpler?

ETHAN

You right.

SEBASTIAN You shouldn't be interesting yourself in anything else.

ETHAN I haven't done anything, I swear.

SEBASTIAN Around me, everyone is a liar.

74.

ETHAN I'm good at what I do.

SEBASTIAN Let's keep it that way.

INT. FOURTH VAN - DAY

Sebastian has a hand gripped around the back of Laura's neck, he throws her into the back of another van.

Sebastian climbs in after her.

Noah goes to follow on but Sebastian pushes him back keeping him out, slamming the doors shut behind him.

Sebastian kicks out at Laura's legs.

SEBASTIAN You were supposed to be my bait.

LAURA Don't touch me like that.

SEBASTIAN He was meant to come out looking for you, but instead he's been running around this whole city begging his old friends and partners for money.

LAURA You've scared him.

SEBASTIAN I've already put the word out, nobody is giving him shit.

Laura looks up at him as he towers over her.

LAURA If I could help you, I would.

Sebastian kicks out at Laura's legs, hard.

SEBASTIAN Don't you lie.

LAURA You're insane.

SEBASTIAN You've given me nothing, he hasn't come looking for you.

75.

LAURA I never said he would.

SEBASTIAN

He could get the word to me easy if he wanted to barter for your life but he's done nothing and you don't know where he is, you don't know anything.

LAURA

Because I don't.

SEBASTIAN en tell me, why do I stil

Then tell me, why do I still have you?

LAURA

Then let me go.

SEBASTIAN

Why don't I just cut your throat right now and leave you to rot right here.

LAURA

Why would he come out, look at you.

SEBASTIAN

Me?

LAURA

You said it yourself, he's running around begging for money, and he's not getting any because of you.

SEBASTIAN He should fear me.

LAURA

And he's not going to come anywhere near you. You're not dumb, you must know that.

SEBASTIAN Then why are you still here?

LAURA I don't have a choice.

SEBASTIAN What use are you to me?

76.

LAURA In here, I'm no use at all.

SEBASTIAN

Right.

LAURA How does he even know that I'm still alive?

SEBASTIAN He knows.

LAURA How? I just keep going from one van to another.

SEBASTIAN

OK.

LAURA I don't even know where I am.

SEBASTIAN

Good.

LAURA Nobody has seen me since you first picked me up.

Sebastian moves away from her, opens up the vans doors.

Noah is still outside, peers in at them.

Noah stands over her with a camera taking pictures.

77.

LAURA Do you really have to do that right now?

NOAH Well according to Sebastian this was your idea.

LAURA Recently I've been doing nothing but dreaming of moving onto my grandma's farm.

NOAH

Then do it.

LAURA

She now lives in a nice retirement home, she doesn't even remember who I am anymore.

NOAH

That sucks.

LAURA

I stopped thinking for myself and I became obsessed with money and soon after that, what people thought of me.

NOAH You lost who you were?

LAURA I built up an image, looking back on it now I was just ugly.

NOAH You're not ugly.

LAURA I can't go back to that.

Noah takes one last picture of Laura. Noah turns the camera around and shows her the image on screen.

NOAH So what do you think?

LAURA

I like it.

NOAH You still want to get out of here?

78.

Laura gets up and moves over to the doors. Laura pulls down on the handles.

Can't get it to open, it's locked from the outside Laura tugs down on the handles over and over whilst staring at Noah.

Sebastian reaches into the back of his jeans and pulls out a gun. Sebastian points it at her.

LAURA Get off of me!

SEBASTIAN

Shut up!

Noah eyes fill up with panic.

NOAH You don't have to hurt her.

SEBASTIAN Lets see if your dead body can flush him out.

Laura screams.

LAURA I can get your money.

NOAH Listen to her.

LAURA Kill me now and you'll get nothing.

NOAH Sebastian please.

LAURA Isn't your money what you want isn't it why you've gone through all of this?

SEBASTIAN You're lying.

LAURA No, we have shared bank accounts, hidden one, secret ones.

NOAH I believe her.

LAURA Ones only we know about. I can get access to them, I can get you something.

80.

NOAH She's right.

LAURA

Even if it's not everything, it's better than nothing.

SEBASTIAN You're just saying what you think I want to hear.

NOAH You've got to calm down.

SEBASTIAN She just doesn't want to die.

SEBASTIAN I can't have you walking around looking like this. But don't be stupid now, do what I say and you'll get to walk away from all of this.

LAURA That's all I want.

CUT TO:

EXT. RIVER BANK - DAY

Noah quickly untied Laura's hands, removes the gag.

NOAH You've still got it haven't you?

LAURA

Yeah.

NOAH You didn't really think I'd throw you in the river did you?

Laura reaches into her pocket and pulls out Noah's phone.

LAURA I thought it was over, why are you helping me.

CUT TO:

EXT. RIVER BANK - DAY

Noah climbs up a steep part of the bank, keeps himself low down to the grass.

Noah sees the car in the near distance, sees Sebastian inside.

Noah watches Sebastian for a moment before creeping back down the bank.

CUT TO:

EXT. RIVER BANK - DAY

Laura's still on Noah's phone, Laura watches as Noah once again returns to her, hisses in her ear.

NOAH

You've got to find out where he is and you've got to do it now.

LAURA Tell me where you are?

ETHAN

(O.S) It's not happening.

LAURA Not even for old times sake?

ETHAN

(O.S) They haven't killed you yet so just keep doing what you're doing and maybe you'll surprise me and end up surviving this just yet.

The sound of a trains horn is heard faintly whilst Ethan has been talking.

Laura's eyes narrow she heard it too.

LAURA You've lied to me so much, so how about a little bit of truth.

ETHAN (O.S) What do you want to know?

Noah keeps glancing back behind him over towards where the car is beyond the trees.

Noah comes back to Laura.

NOAH If you can't find him now we're both fucked.

LAURA

Wait.

NOAH If you really don't want to die find out where he is now.

Laura pushes Noah back, a hand into his chest. Laura waves Noah off, dismissive.

Ethan clears his throat.

ETHAN (O.S) Are you still there?

LAURA You're still smoking aren't you?

ETHAN

(O.S) Really?

LAURA You promised to quit but you're still doing it, stressed?

ETHAN

(O.S) Yeah, you'd be right about that.

LAURA It's obvious.

ETHAN (O.S) Who wouldn't be stressed.

LAURA Go on now, I want to hear you do it.

ETHAN

(O.S) Why?

LAURA I knew you'd never quit.

ETHAN

It's hard.

LAURA I just want one last I told you so.

We can hear Ethan now rummage through his pockets. Ethan sparks up a lighter and opens up a window and begins smoking.

The trains horn sounds out again for a second time and with the window now open Laura can hear it much more clearly through the phone. Laura checks the time.

Laura turns to Noah, holds out his phone for him to take.

LAURA (CONT'D) I know where he is.

NOAH

You do?

Laura takes Noah by the hand and they both break off into a sprint.

CUT TO:

EXT. RIVER BANK - DAY

Laura and Noah are out of breath, sprinting hand in hand, running along the river bank, keeping themselves low and trying to stay out of sight.

Sebastian comes stumbling down the grass in front of them, hurrying over towards the water, seeing Sebastian Noah and Laura come to a stop.

Sebastian comes to a stop in front of them. Sebastian pulls out his gun.

Sebastian takes aim at Noah.

Laura puts up her hands, surrendering.

Sebastian squares up to Noah.

SEBASTIAN What the fuck Noah?

NOAH I'm sorry. I can't kill her.

SEBASTIAN You kill her now, or that's the end of you.

NOAH

I can't.

Sebastian turns his gun around, spins it in his hand offers it handle first to Noah.

NOAH (CONT'D)

No.

SEBASTIAN Do it, or die.

NOAH You could just let us go.

SEBASTIAN Shoot this bitch.

NOAH

Never.

Noah snatches the gun from Sebastian. With his left hand Noah takes a hold of Laura's.

Noah backs away from Sebastian.

SEBASTIAN

Stop. Stay.

Noah shakes his head.

LAURA (To Sebastian) I know where he is.

SEBASTIAN

Shut up.

LAURA There's an apartment he uses.

SEBASTIAN I said enough.

LAURA You'd get no sleep there, nothing but trains.

SEBASTIAN

Trains?

LAURA You know what I'm talking about don't you?

Sebastian's eyes get big.

Sebastian throws himself at Noah, tackles him to the ground. Sebastian sits on top of him, punches him in the face and knocks the gun out of Noah's hand.

Sebastian goes to pick it up but before he can Laura kicks the gun away from them and into the river.

LAURA (CONT'D) You'll be the one who lets Ethan go if you do nothing now!

Sebastian looks down at Noah and punches him again, several hard blows to his face and head, spliting his lips and breaking his nose.

Noah is half unconscious, beaten into a daze.

Laura attacks Sebastian, tries to wrestle him off from Noah.

Sebastian wraps his hands around Noah's throat and begins to squeeze the life out of him.

Laura screams, using all her strength she's able to pull Sebastian off from Noah.

Sebastian gets up, glances down at Noah. Cut up, bruised and barely breathing. Sebastian turns to Laura.

SEBASTIAN You'll never be safe in this city.

INT. FOURTH VAN - FRONT SEATS - DAY

As the sun begins to go down Noah, his face a swollen mess drives along the wide open highway nothing in front of them and the city behind.

Laura opens her mouth to say something but thinks better of it. She shuffles herself closer to him and rests her head against Noah's shoulder.

INT. APARTMENT - DAY

Ethan sits at the open window smoking. Sebastian slowly approaches him a knife in his right hand.

Ethan looks over at him, tears rolling down his face he can't help but laugh.

Ethan continues to smoke, Sebastian continues to move over towards him. He holds the knife up high, ready to attack.

EXT. FARM - DAY

Laura and Noah holding hands walk away from the parked car and head towards a farm house as the sun sets behind them.
